- 1. Regular Standing Order. This is the most popular way to give, and helps the Church plan its expenditure. You decide the frequency and amount of giving to suit your needs. It is easy to set up a standing order, or to make changes to it, using online banking or by contacting your local branch with our bank details. Please do not hesitate to change your standing order should your circumstances change.
- 2. One-off Donations. Some people do not feel comfortable with a regular commitment to give and prefer to give as and when they feel able to do so. Or, perhaps you may feel you wish to share part of an inheritance or an annual bonus. We are extremely grateful for every donation, however it is made and whatever the amount.
- 3. Legacies. If you are engaged in estate planning, or preparing a will, we ask you to consider including the church as a beneficiary to support our work.
- 4. Cheque or Charity Voucher (eg Stewardship Voucher or CAF Voucher). These should be made payable to PCC of St John with St Andrew.
- 5. Your Employer's Payroll Giving Scheme. Many employers offer Payroll Giving Schemes, some with matched funding options. If this might suit you, please speak with your HR department and provide them with our charity details.
